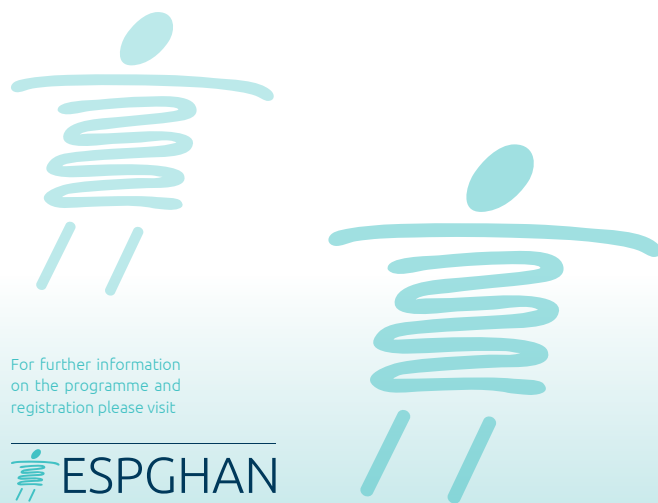
**Expected numbers:** minimum 30, maximum 40 delegates
